All children attending school must be in compliance with the current State School Immunization Laws, Rules and Regulations. School districts are mandated to enforce this law on behalf of the State Department of Health. Per Bullitt County requirements for enrollment as stated in 09.121 AP.1, each child shall have been immunized according to testing and immunizations schedules established by regulations of the Cabinet for Health Services. Medical or Religious Exemptions can apply to testing or immunization requirements.

Children who are not adequately immunized, in progress, or properly exempted may be excluded from school until a new form is brought to the school.

Due to changes outlined in 902 KAR 2:060 for 2018-2019 school year, ALL students in kindergarten through twelfth grade must show proof of having received two doses of Hepatitis A vaccine to attend school. This is a NEW school attendance requirement. Please see below regarding your child's status on immunizations.

It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to provide the child's immunization records to the school.

Based on the immunization information available at the school we:

_____ have all the shots recorded on correct form to start school in August. Nothing else is needed.

_____ need IMMUNIZATION certificate- showing proof of Hepatitis A shot(s). *(Please note: your child may start school in August with one dose of Hepatitis A)* A second shot for Hepatitis A will be needed 6 months following the first shot for your child to remain enrolled. Please make appointment for follow-up in timely manner to avoid missing school.

_____ need state accepted IMMUNIZATION certificate. Your child appears to have the required shots for the regulation; however, we need the information transferred to a current immunization that is accepted by state.

_____ need new RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION form submitted as the old forms are no longer accepted by State.

You have until MAY 1, 2018 to take care of this important matter. Following this date, your child's name will be given to Pupil Personnel and Health Services for exclusion to the school.

_____ School physicals are needed for entry into sixth grade. *This is different from athletic forms.* Your child will need a copy of the Preventive Health Examination form before starting school next year. Make appointment now for the summer to obtain this additional requirement. Please keep copy for your records.
